My choice of text from these magazines is purely random, in the sense that I flick through magazine pages in any order, without any pre-conceived pattern, and subjective, in the sense that I simply select what appeals to me. This selection tends to be, from a poetic perspective, specific images or, from a prosaic perspective, single clauses. There is no consciously pre-identified theme or template that governs this selection. The construction of the poem, as these components are chosen, is far from random, however. Certain images tend to define a theme and my ordering of textual components responds to this. This is a completely conscious operation. The personal journey in each poem is exhilarating, as I experience words that others have offered, being shaped by me, into poetic expressions of my own thoughts and feelings.
