Until the end of the 1990s Zimbabwewas considered as the breadbasket of southern Africa (Tarisayi 2009: 11). Zimbabwe wasone of Africa s role models in terms of educational system, a free press, independent judiciaryand consolidated economy by then long time governed by Robert Mugabe. The Zimbabweandilemma started when the military intervened in a costly conflict in the DR Congo in 1998and started to ruin its own economy. Two years later Mugabe encouraged occupations of white commercial farms. By intentionally weakening one of the most vibrant economicsectors Zimbabwe soon faced high inflation rates, food shortages and growing unemployment. By 2008, the year of elections Zimbabwe according to IMF formed the fastest shrinking economy in the world with four million people in desperate need of food (Tarisayi 2009: 11-13). After the formation of a power-sharing arrangement in 2008 the crucial question was if such aconstruction would work for Zimbabwe. In addition to the enormous challenges within thecountry there are many reservations concerning powersharing arrangements in general as the concept already failed in many African countries before (Roeder and Rothchild 2005: 41). There were many actors involved such as SADC, AU and South Africa who were playing avital role in negotiating the Global Political Agreement (GPA) which makes it necessary tohave a closer look on their role in this process (EISA 2008: 78).
