Browne, the Battalion Adjutant, compiled this history, which includes full listings of those who took part, and of the local branch of Cumann na mBan, the Women's Army. Originally privately published in the early 1970s, this new edition, the first for commercial sale, carries a foreword by his daughter and photo illustrations from the family collection.
